Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: I've never flown a model aircraft before. Can I still join your club?

A: Yes! We joyfully welcome members of all ages and experience levels.

Q: Do you offer training for aspiring pilots?

Q: What type of model aircraft can I fly at Sportsman's Park?

A: All remote control electric or gas aircraft are welcome, including airplanes, helicopters and drones.

A: Equipment costs vary and can be selected based on your budget. Club membership does require yearly dues paid to Flight Masters and to the AMA.
